Purpose:

The purpose of this award is to recognize student leadership training programs in the residence halls.

Eligibility:

One student or student group of a NACURH member school in good standing may submit a SALT nomination for consideration each year.

Requirements:

Bids will be no longer than 20 pages.

Suggested Bid Criteria:

- ▶ Write a one-paragraph summary of the SALT nomination that could be used in describing the nomination as a conference program session.
- ▶ Describe the goals and objectives of the SALT nomination.
- ▶ Describe the specific student needs that this project is attempting to address.
- ▶ Describe the resources used in developing the project, including a budget, funding, sources, personnel needs, supplies utilized, etc.
- ▶ Describe the planning process used in the development of the project.
- ▶ Describe who, what, when, where, etc.
- ▶ Describe how your project relates to the ACPA conference delegates.
- ▶ Describe how this project affects students.
- ▶ Discuss the results of the project and show what evaluation methods were used.
- ▶ Describe how this project would be presented in a conference session format.
- ▶ Describe what media would be used in the conference session (slides, transparencies, film, etc.).
- ▶ Describe any handouts and written materials that would be distributed to conference delegates.
